



Tour Safety

Know before you go!

- Visitors must be 18 years or older.
- No backpacks, handbags or other bags are allowed inside Reclamation facilities.
- Photography is allowed outside the facility.
- Photography is **not** allowed inside the facility.
- Smoking is not allowed in federal buildings or within 50 feet (15 m) of entrances to federal buildings.
- Please let us know if you have any medical conditions that may put your safety at risk.
- Please drink plenty of water during the day of your trip.

Please wear appropriate clothing.

- Closed-toe shoes with good tread (no sandals)
- Jeans or pants (no shorts or skirts)
- Sunscreen for outside. Most of our facilities are in sunny, high-altitude areas and you can sunburn very quickly.

Avoid hazards during the tour.

- Overhead hazards: Hard hats must be worn and will be provided.
- Chemical or flammable hazards: Eye protection is required and will be provided.
- High noise areas: Hearing protection is required and will be provided.
- Electric hazards: Avoid walking close to electrical cabinets. Follow the warning signs.
Do not touch anything!
- Fall and tripping hazards: Use handrails when available. Watch for wet floors or tripping hazards. Do not lean over any railings.
